For applications to be considered complete, you must include the following:

- A completed application form.
- A curriculum vitae. Include formal education, teachers, and any other information you may find relevant.
- A one or two paragraph statement discussing the relevance of analysis for you in performance.
- One letter of recommendation.
- A recent CD or cassette recording of your most representative work. At least 2 works from different style periods must be included. Solo performances are acceptable.
- All recordings must be clearly marked with complete information about the performances:
 - Title and Composer
 - Where and when performed
- A \$50 application fee before January 18, 2008 (\$75 application fee for students residing outside the U.S). Check or money order payable to European American Musical Alliance, Inc..
- A \$75 application fee after January 18, 2008.
- A self-addressed stamped enveloped for the return of your materials, if desired.
